The Chicago Police Memorial Foundation has paid out more than \$2.6 million to outfit 7,067 Chicago Police Officers with replacement bulletproof vests through the Get Behind the Vest program. The initiative is ongoing and we project 500 officers a year will need new vests in the future. On Sunday, February 26, Alderman Matt O'Shea is hosting a pancake breakfast to support this effort. Your donation ensures that every officer out there protecting you is protected.

When Chicago Police Officers are hired, they receive a new bulletproof vest. However, a vest isn't bulletproof forever.

It wears out. It breaks down. It needs to be replaced every 5 years. Just one bullet permanently damages a vest, making it unusable. Chicago Police Officers are responsible for replacing their own vests. At \$500 or more per vest, in addition to other equipment and uniform expenses, the costs can quickly add up. That's why we need your help.
